<b>Description and Information</b>  A number of buildings in the Home Farm Complex which originally served Foxbury mansion.  Bothy Cottage is a row of farm buildings aligned parallel to the Victorian stables. Slate roof, whitewashed walls, timber sash windows – those at first floor breaking the eaves.  When considered with Polo Mews this is an attractive group of architectural and historic interest. Makes a positive contribution to the character and appearance of the Chislehurst Conservation Area.
