URGENT

Do you want to vote at the European Parliamentary Election on 23 May 2019?

As I am sure you are aware, the UK was not due to take part in the European Parliamentary Election this year.

However, due to current circumstances it is likely that the UK will have to participate in the European Parliamentary election on 23 May 2019 and as a consequence we have been instructed to commence preparations for this election.

You are currently registered at this address to vote at local council elections in Bromley, but you are **not** entitled to vote at the European Parliamentary Election in this country.

As a European citizen, you may have already registered to vote in your home state. However if you have not/do not wish to register in your home state, then you can apply to vote here, if the election is held. If so, please **complete and return the enclosed application and declaration form** to us by post by **Tuesday 7 May 2019**.

Alternatively, you can scan and email the completed form back to electoral@bromley.gov.uk

Please note that:

- You may vote only once, in one member state, at the European Parliamentary election
- There is a possibility that the European Parliamentary election will still not take place in the UK. If this were to occur then your application to vote here will not apply and, if possible you will need to make alternative arrangements

European Union citizens – European Parliament voter registration form (GB)

If you are a citizen of one of the European Union (EU) countries listed below, you can register to vote in the UK at a European Parliamentary election.

If you are a citizen of the UK, Republic of Ireland, Malta or Cyprus, you are eligible to register to vote at all UK elections and so **do not** need to use this form. If you are not already registered to vote you can register at [gov.uk/register-to-vote](https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote)

Please read the following information before you fill in this form.

- This form only registers you for European Parliamentary elections. You must be included or be applying for inclusion on the register of local electors by your electoral registration office. If you are not already registered to vote you can register at [gov.uk/register-to-vote](https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote)
- You cannot vote at the European Parliamentary elections in more than one country. If you fill in this form, you are agreeing to vote in the UK only and not in your home country. But remember, you can cancel this registration up until **12 working days before the poll**.
- If you intend to vote in the European Parliamentary elections in your home country rather than the UK, do not complete this form.
- Completing this form does not affect your voting rights for elections other than the European Parliamentary elections, either in the UK or your home country.

- This form must reach your electoral registration office **12 working days before the poll**.

Where to send your form

If you live in England or Wales, please return this form to your electoral registration office at your local council. If you live in Scotland, please return this form to your electoral registration officer, who may be located in a separate office. Privacy statement

The Electoral Registration Officer will only use the information you give them for electoral purposes. They will look after personal information securely and will follow data protection legislation. They will not give personal information about you or any personal information you may provide on other people to anyone else or another organisation unless they have to by law.

The lawful basis to collect the information in this form is that it is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest and exercise of official authority as vested in the Electoral Registration Officer as set out in Representation of the People Act 1983 and associated regulations.
